Admission Requirements

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- Complete an application for admission online at www.egcc.edu
- Take the Reading COMPASS assessment to establish college readiness (Reading Sub Score of 88 as determined by the State)
- Students interested in taking math or English will need to take the COMPASS English and math assessments to establish college readiness in those subject areas, ACT/SAT scores may waive assessment(s)



2015-2016 Priority Deadlines

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- By **April 1, 2015** notify your school counselor if you intend to participate in College Credit Plus in the 2015/2016 school year
- Complete EGCC application for admission and COMPASS assessment by **May 15, 2015**
- Discuss your high school schedule and your desired EGCC courses with your school counselor
 - If you plan to take coursework on the EGCC campus you must schedule courses with an Admissions Advisor by **August 21, 2015**
 - If you plan to take EGCC coursework offered at your high school you must schedule with your school counselor when making your high school schedule
